Lottery Credit Online Application Portal	<p>Property owners should use this portal to apply for or remove a lottery and gaming credit.</p> <p>In the portal, you are directed to the correct e-file lottery and gaming credit form (LC-115, LC-315, LC-320, LC-400). File and submit your application online without the added step of printing, mailing, or emailing.</p> <p>Note: All late claim lottery and gaming credit applications (LC-315, LC-320) must be submitted via the online application portal by the October 1 deadline.</p>

Filing Instructions

1. As you complete the form:
 - o Follow the instructions on the right side panel
 - o Check for accuracy
 - o Resolve any errors
2. Attach an electronic copy (jpeg, pdf, etc.) of your 2023 property tax bill
3. Click "Submit" when the form is complete
4. Before exiting, print and save a copy for your records (including your confirmation number)

Filing period:

- To apply for the 2023 credit: February 1, 2024 - October 1, 2024

You may claim this credit:

- For 2023 property taxes, payable in 2024, if on January 1, 2023, you were the owner of the property and used the property as your primary residence
- If you did not receive this credit on your 2023 property tax bill
- If you have only one primary residence
- If you purchased the home after the January 1, 2023 certification date and the previous owner used the home as a primary residence on January 1, 2023

You cannot claim this credit:

- On business property, rental units, land, garages or other properties that are not your primary residence
- If the property was unoccupied on January 1, 2023
- If you are not a Wisconsin resident
- If the property was neither your primary residence, nor the primary residence of the previous owner, on January 1, 2023

Click 2023 to file a **LATE CLAIM** for tax year 2023.
